## June Board meeting highlights

The Cooperative Board of Directors met in regular session on Thursday, June 28. Highlights of that meeting follow:

- The Board approved the applications of 75 new members to the Cooperative.
- A grant was approved through the *Public Safety Education Grant Program* for \$5,000 to the Village of Logan for area law enforcement training.
- Two grants from the *Innovation in Schools Grant Program* were awarded to:
  - ~ Vaughn Municipal Schools for \$5,000 to purchase printers and supplies.
  - ~ Clayton Municipal Schools for \$5,000 to purchase a subscription to BrainPOP, an online learning tool for third-graders.
- A construction status report was presented to the Board and included:
  - ~ Conversion of members from copper cable to the new fiber-optic network in the El Valle exchange continues.
  - ~ Work continues on the Fiber-to-the-premise project in the Conchas Dam exchange.
  - ~ Completed certain projects in the San Jon, Santa Rosa and South Clovis exchanges.
  - ~ Work continues on extended range DSL subscribers.
  - ~ Work continues on projects in the Clayton, Weber City and House exchanges.

The next regular Board meeting is scheduled for Thursday, July 26, at the Cooperative's offices north of Clovis.
